Broadacre Harvest Operations*

New to the agricultural industry? Get the skills and knowledge to safely undertake employment for harvest operations in the broadacre sector.

Broadacre Seeding Operations*

Gain the skills you need to safely apply chemicals; and operate a range of machinery used for broadacre seeding, including tractors, boomsprays and air seeders to comply with work health and safety procedures.

Green Jobs - Seed Collection*

Develop your knowledge about plants and practical skills required to support the collection, treatment and storage of seed that can be applied to revegetation projects, habitat restoration and the protection of existing and native vegetation.

Hospitality Service*

Prepare to work as a barista, front of house food and beverage attendant, or back of house kitchen attendant.

Livestock Handling*

Are you an existing agricultural worker or looking to enter the industry? Learn to handle livestock and comply with industry animal welfare requirements with this skill set.

Aquatic Facilities Technical Operations

Learn how to operate and maintain aquatic facilities utilised by the public, in accordance with the WA Health Legislative Requirements.

Backpack and Boom Spray

Undertake this combined skill set to increase knowledge and skills when spraying chemicals, to meet the Department of Health's training requirements for a Pest Management Technician License. Perfect for those that apply chemicals (spraying) as part of paid employment or contracted work.

Conduct Civil Construction Excavator Operations

Skill up and learn how to operate excavator operations to lift, carry and place materials.

Conduct Civil Construction Skid Steer Loader Operations

Develop the skills and knowledge to operate a skid steer loader to load, haul and distribute materials.

Operate and Maintain Chainsaw

Learn the theoretical and practical elements of identifying hazards, personal protective equipment, safety features, pre-start checks and maintenance, chain sharpening, safe starts, operation and cutting techniques and more!

Operate Basic Machinery and Equipment

Get the skills required for pre-start checks, operate, maintain and shut down basic machinery and equipment used in the agricultural, horticulture and land management industry sectors.

Undertake Operational Maintenance of Machinery

Learn to undertake the operational maintenance of machinery, select the required tools and equipment, carry out lubrication and basic servicing with this skill set.
